

Seven Steps To Keep From Receiving The Blessings of God

Gen. 3:1-12

Follow these seven steps if you do not care to receive God's blessings in your life:

1. Listen to the voice of the devil (vv. 1, 4-5).

a. Don't bother to resist him or shut off the voice of temptation from the outset. Get a good earful of his lies and believe them. Of course he'll come questioning the integrity of God, but who cares. You don't want any of God's blessings any way, so listen to the devil.

2. Twist Scripture to your own satisfaction (vv. 2-3).

a. This will help to justify any sin that you want to engage in. It'll help still the voice of your conscience and it will justify you before those other sickening holy roller Christians who call themselves trying to steer you on the right path.

b. Of course it's an insult to God that you twist His Word (Deut. 4:2; Prov. 6:2; Rev. 22:18-19) But who cares. You really don't want His blessings in your life anyway, so just twist His Word to your hearts desire.

3. Go ahead and just blatantly disobey God's Word (v. 6).

a. Yeah, we know that He gives you His commandments because He loves you and does not want to see you hurt. Ah, but who cares. You owe it to yourself to sin and make a mess of your life. How can you enjoy life if you're not in sin and misery. Those who are experiencing the abundant blessings of obeying God's word sure don't know what they're missing.

4. Lead others in to your sin with you (v. 6).

a. Hey, why enjoy the fruit of sin alone. It takes two to tangle baby. Misery should never be without company. You know how wonderful it is not to have God's blessings so share the miser....., AHEM! I mean joys of sinful bliss with others.

5. When you sin, instead of running to God, just try to cover it up (v. 7).

a. Of course the Bible says that he who covers his sin will not prosper (Prov. 28:13). Heck, that's what you're trying to avoid anyway.

6. When God reaches out to you, don't humble yourself before Him (v. 8).

a. Instead go run and hide. All he's going to do is forgive you and bring you back into fellowship with Him. After that He's going to pour out all kinds of blessings as though you had never sinned. Who needs that?

7. When you are caught, don't admit to sinning. Blame somebody else.

a. Tell Him you were framed, deceived, talked into it. Tell Him the devil made you do it like Eve did. Blame God Himself like Adam did if you have to. Do anything to take the blame away from yourself.

Follow these seven steps and beyond a shadow of doubt you won't have to worry about all those annoying blessings God wants to give you. However, if you can't seem to live without God and His blessings, (sigh!) just do the opposite of what we've told you and you'll get blessed. But we warn you, you're going to miss out on all the misery.... er, ahem, excuse me, joys of sinfulness.
