1. The Father loves you

A. John 16:23-27; 1 John 4:10; Rom. 8:32-39

2. God is a FAITHFUL God

1 John 1:7-9

Psalm 145:13

(NCV) Your kingdom will go on and on, and you will rule forever. The Lord will keep all his promises; he is loyal to all he has made.

(Brenton) (144:13) Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion *endures* through all generations. (144:13A) The Lord is faithful in his words, and holy in all his works.

(MSG) Your kingdom is a kingdom eternal; you never get voted out of office. GOD always does what he says, and is gracious in everything he does.

(NLT)

For your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom.

You rule generation after generation.

The LORD is faithful in all he says;
he is gracious in all he does.^[2]

Psa 9:9 The Lord also will be a refuge and a high tower for the oppressed, a refuge and a stronghold in times of trouble (high cost, destitution, and desperation).

Psa 9:10 And they who know Your name [who have experience and acquaintance with Your mercy] will lean on and confidently put their trust in You, for You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek (inquire of and for) You [on the authority of God's Word and the right of their necessity].⁽³⁾

Psa 9:11 Sing praises to the Lord, Who dwells in Zion! Declare among the peoples His doings!

3. God is able to do what He said that He would do

Matthew 19:26; compare to Mark 9:23. Gen. 18:14; compare to Romans 4:19-22

Jeremiah 32:17

(BBE) Ah Lord God! see, you have made the heaven and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm, and there is nothing you are not able to do:

(GNB) "Sovereign LORD, you made the earth and the sky by your great power and might; nothing is too difficult for you.
